Ministry Spotlight: A Recent Helpline call

A recent caller, *Erica*, contacted us seeking abortion services. Our volunteer lay-counselor learned in the conversation that *Erica* had an abortion in the past, and had vowed she would never do it again. *Erica* also had the experience of a late-term miscarriage, and she has an older child as well. But because of financial difficulties and struggles in her relationship with the baby's father, she was leaning toward abortion once more.

"My heart wants to keep this baby, but my mind tells me I don't have to," *Erica* said. It is hard for most of us to understand this kind of thinking, but it is rationalization like *Erica's* that leads to abortions every day. That is why we at WELS Lutherans for Life are grateful for the opportunity to speak with people when they are at this crucial decision-making point. We are privileged to share the truth with them—the truth about abortion and human life and ultimately, eternal life with Jesus.

Even though she followed up with the caller, our counselor never learned what *Erica* finally decided to do. The counselor was confident, though, that she had done what she could by relying on the Holy Spirit to guide her as she responded to this expecting mother. She and the staff prayed that her words would have a positive, life-saving effect.

Message from the Executive Director

The recent trial of abortionist Kermit Gosnell in Philadelphia forced us to look at the horrors of the abortion industry. Since that time the pro-life community is seeing some encouraging news. Following Gosnell's conviction for taking the lives of babies delivered alive after abortion and for taking the life of a female client, many states began looking more closely at the abortion mills.

As a result, some abortion centers have closed their doors. That's good news. It is also good news when state legislatures, like those in Wisconsin and Texas, move to limit and better regulate abortion.

Now it is time to take the next step: ending abortion as we know it.

Unfathomable? A mere pipe dream? Possibly. Or, is this far more realistic than we can imagine?

Think about this. What if, in our community, every woman or couple facing an unplanned pregnancy thought of *Associated Pregnancy Services* before going anywhere else? And what if they came in *our* door to consider their options before heading to an abortion mill?

When women come to us, they hear the truth—about abortion and about human life. They learn the facts about abortion procedures and risks as well as the long-term devastation abortion can have on their lives. They are shown that a human life begins at conception as a unique individual created by God. And, most importantly, they hear the gospel message.

Think of the impact: Let's extrapolate this across our nation. If *every* pregnancy care center like ours shared the same message of truth, and all of the 2500 centers in America became this "first choice," what would happen? People's hearts would be changed, and then...the abortion rate would drop precipitously, would it not?

And without customers, abortion facilities (perhaps almost all) would naturally close.

Our goal to end abortion can be reached. With God guiding people in their choices, we could become the "first choice." We need adequate funding for marketing (to reach those who need us), facilities, staffing, and the many services we provide. With the best in marketing, facilities, and services, we will be that first choice. This is not impossible at all with God.

Would this mean the *end* of abortion? I know for certain there would be far fewer lives destroyed. And we would love the opportunity to try. It would be exciting to see.
