A very anxious young woman came through our doors a couple of weeks ago. "Hi, *Anna*! It's good to see you again." *Anna* had come in several times over the past few years for pregnancy tests. This time she didn't want to believe her symptoms were truly saying she was pregnant. Tears filled her eyes as the "+" line appeared on her test. She was feeling overwhelmed. She and her fiancé each have several children. Their finances are in bad shape. She is on meds for several health issues, and she dreads the reaction of her extended family.

As *Anna* poured out her heart, the counselor listened with empathy, acknowledging *Anna's* difficulties and encouraging *her*. Though *Anna* showed no real interest in God, she did give him credit as she said, "God gives babies for a reason." We are grateful she and her fiancé are adamantly against abortion.

The counselor relates, "Your situation, *Anna*, reminds me of the sermon I heard recently. It was about the night when Jesus and his friends were out in their fishing boat going from one side of the lake to the other. His friends had just spent the day watching Jesus do miracle after miracle, and earlier they had seen how powerful he is. Suddenly a fierce storm hit their boat. They rowed as hard as they could, but were getting nowhere. Their fear overpowered them. They quickly forgot their friend who lay asleep in the boat was the powerful Lord. They woke Jesus with the words, 'Master, Master don't you care if we drown?' They had forgotten to trust their powerful friend and 'Master' to carry them through this fierce storm.

Let's scale the wall together! I'm grateful you are with me—on this team—advancing the culture of life into the future. Thank you for your prayers, partnership, and financial support!




