From 3 years... to Life


Claire is a petite young woman with delicate features on a sad countenance. Her mild manner belied her history of drug abuse and related crimes. Although she had been in rehab for many months, she had gotten into more trouble, and she found herself facing several years of incarceration. Now, her inkling was confirmed—she was pregnant.

Claire's social worker had called our pregnancy center. He said that she was considering abortion, and had an appointment with Planned Parenthood, but was also thinking of adoption. Her social worker (apparently a pro-life Christian) found our center's website, and called our helpline, asking if we would be willing to come to the jail. He believed that whoever reached Claire first would have the greatest impact on her pregnancy decision.

Claire welcomed my visit. She is normally allowed only one outside visitor per week, and I learned that she has no supportive family members or friends, and no religious beliefs. As we talked, I sensed her warming up to me. My heart went out to her when she asked if it was a nice dayshe sure couldn't tell from inside the windowless building.

We discussed her options: abortion, parenting, and adoption. Claire told me that she had a previous abortion. She thinks women should have the choice of abortion, but she wants to experience pregnancy. Claire said she is certain she never wants to have kids, but especially not under these circumstances. She thinks adoption would be her most loving option. She talked about not getting too attached before placing the baby, so I knew she was already starting to have feelings for her child.

I explained to Claire that as the birth mom, she is in the driver's seat when making an adoption plan. She can choose the family and the type of adoption. This was empowering for Claire, who has so little control in her life



right now. I gave her referrals to adoption agencies and offered to walk with her through the pregnancy. Claire really liked to hear that, and she was grateful for my visit.

The social worker expressed his thanks for our willingness to come to the jail; he said it was a divine thing. He loves our APS client website, and he said that our neutral presentation and factual description of options made him very comfortable calling us. He commended our work and welcomes us to begin ongoing ministry with pregnant and
