Lillie was in college and found out she was pregnant. She came to our clinic for an ultrasound.

While Lillie was going over her information with our client advocate, she revealed that when she was younger, she had an abortion. Now she found herself wrestling with another challenging pregnancy decision.

The baby's father was not committed to their relationship or even really demonstrating that he loved *Lillie*, so she knew she would have to be self-sufficient. Her choices were to take care of herself, alone, or she would have to take care of herself and a child. She expressed loneliness.



But during that first visit *Lillie* recognized a friendly face in our advocate. She realized that she had found a friend, someone she could really talk to. Someone that showed compassion and a commitment to her and her baby's care and well-being.

Lillie was able to see that even if her baby's father was not involved, she would still be supported at the WELS Lutherans for Life pregnancy clinic in Milwaukee.

Lillie was cared for in that initial time of crisis. Lillie and her baby continue to benefit from your love and support they receive every time *Lillie* visits the pregnancy clinic.

No Insurance - No Problem

The helpline rang and the caller identified herself as *Luci*. Her sister needed immediate help.

Luci said her twin sister Judi was new in town, having moved here for a job. *Judi* had the job, but her insurance wouldn't begin until the next month. *Judi* had taken a pregnancy test, and it was positive.

This was *Judi's* first pregnancy and because she was in her early 40's, she was very anxious and eager to see someone right away. But no doctor would see her until her insurance kicked in.

She called Planned Parenthood, thinking they could help her, but she was told they couldn't do anything for her if she planned to carry the child to full term. Planned Parenthood also told her they did not provide prenatal care. She was surprised and very unhappy with the lack of help available from Planned Parenthood.

So the sister's search for help continued. God led her to our

information. She called to make an appointment with us and was absolutely thrilled that we could see her so soon, that our center could help before her insurance kicked in.

Judi came in for her visit, meeting with the client advocate. She received her first ultrasound. She left with some prenatal vitamins and, more importantly, the peace of mind that everything was okay with her baby. She intends to carry her child and is considering joining the Loving Parents classes.
