Olivia called wanting to walk-in for an ultrasound. We fit her into the schedule that same day.

"He wants her to have their baby."

When the advocate asked Olivia if the pregnancy was planned, she said, "No, no, NO!" Her relationship with the baby's father is casual. Her boyfriend already has kids and is involved in their lives.

Olivia told her baby's father that she is considering having an abortion. But he wants her to have their baby. This caused some conflict because she doesn't feel it is the right time to have a baby. She works full-time and her child, a son, will soon start school. Olivia put off going to college when she had him. But she was planning to start soon...



... and then this pregnancy happened. She really just wants an abortion.

Olivia works with the elderly and vulnerable. She also has a large support system. She confessed that the father would be really happy if she keeps their baby.

During her ultrasound, the advocate discussed Olivia's compassionate heart...

"Olivia, do you realize how compassionate you are? I hear it in

Creating Courage

"Creating Courage" was the theme of a recent Loving Parents class. It included everything from what it means to be courageous to how to foster courage in children.

One of the lesson's key points is that courage isn't the absence of fear, but taking action despite it. Perhaps that's the difference between courage and stupidity.

The parents that day learned that courage can be taught and modeled. Courage is:

- often demonstrated by our clients, who, despite all odds, give their best as moms and dads.
- the dad encouraging a choice for life despite real fears.
- shown in our volunteers facing challenging situations with compassion and God's truth.

During class, we discussed fears. One of the parents shared her anxiety over having "the talk" with her oldest daughter. As she talked about her apprehensions, a dad in the class echoed those same feelings. They were both hungry for help in this area. It was clear this was important to them, that they love their children, and that they had no training in this area.

I happened to be the substitute teacher that day. As the Healthy Choices Program Director, I routinely lead discussions with adolescents and parents on difficult topics like sex.

These Loving Parents were eager to gain guidance and knowledge for dealing with this awkward but important topic. I shared practical advice and provided relevant resources. Everyone was grateful for the discussion, encouragement, and materials they received.

As Nelson Mandela famously said, "Courage [is] not the absence of fear, but the triumph over it." And Psalm 31:24 (NIV) says, "Be strong and take heart, all you who hope in the LORD."




Olivia was seriously considering aborting her second child when she first contacted us. After she arrived for her ultrasound, Olivia was evaluated as "abortion-minded."
