Does a Life have a Price Tag?

Money! Money is a strong force. The lack of money is a burning reason for Kim to seek an abortion. A single mother of a nine-year-old boy, Kim discovered she was pregnant. She sought out our pregnancy center for information about an abortion. She has a job at a nursing home, yet she struggles daily to pay bills. A second child would make life even more financially exhausting. Kim knows she can't depend on the baby's father for child support. Anxious about her future, Kim seems convinced that an abortion will be her best solution.

Kim is right, delivering and rearing a child is definitely not cheap! But Colleen, one of our client advocates, encouraged Kim to slow down and consider this miracle growing inside of her. Colleen showed Kim pictures of a baby in these early stages of life, hoping to help Kim connect with her baby.

While an abortion can be a short-term financial fix, Colleen explained there are risks involved in the different abortion procedures, which can also be costly in other ways. Kim was already aware of the emotional complications for post-abortive women. Colleen tenderly described the costly spiritual risks when we turn away from God, taking the quick and easy—yet sinful—way out.

As Kim's thought progressed she confided that she had longed to have another baby. Although this was definitely not an ideal financial situation, she believed God had listened to her. Colleen and Kim talked



about the fact that God had a plan for her and her child. She agreed to have Colleen schedule a free ultrasound appointment for her at another pro-life agency so she could see a picture of her little one.

Kim came in convinced that abortion was her best solution. She left that day at peace. The Holy Spirit working through Colleen had convinced her that the child growing in her is a valuable human being. She was relieved that she had slowed down to see her situation in a new light.

We are thankful God used Colleen that day to listen and share the truth with Kim!

Women rejects abortion after she sees her baby on ultrasound

Rebekah Nancarrow had an ultrasound at Planned Parenthood (for which she paid \$80), but wasn't allowed to see the image. She was told by a Planned Parenthood worker that seeing the fetus on the screen "will only make it harder on you."

Nancarrow later went to a crisis pregnancy center and was given a free ultrasound. This time she was allowed to view it. Nancarrow was so moved by what she saw on the ultrasound screen that she changed her mind about having an abortion and decided to have her baby. She says:

Had I not had the sonogram, I would have had the abortion. But that sonogram just confirmed 100% to me that this was a life within me, not a tissue or glob.

Nancarrow's story reveals two things. One, that pregnancy resource centers are lifesavers and should be supported by pro-lifers. Two, that there is a reason why pro-abortion groups like Planned Parenthood fight against laws allowing women to see their baby on the ultrasound screen. Living on a fixed income isn't easy, but when people get inspired by the work done at WELS Lutherans for Life centers, some find interesting ways to still be generous.

After attending the Evening for Life for the first time in October 2015, Lauri Neumann set her mind to exactly that goal. Although she is legally blind, her can-do attitude, love for the Lord, desire to serve others, and delicate persistence in enlisting others' cooperation allowed her to donate \$100 recently.

Lauri has a truck. She can't drive it because of her limited vision, but she has friends and family. At times she has been asked to organize a crew to empty out storage lockers when their owners don't keep up with the monthly fees. She tries to find owners for the items, because she hates to see good stuff go to waste.

Recently a brand new Hawaii-style tiki hut (gazebo style) made of solid wood was left unassembled in a locker. When Lauri couldn't find anyone with the space to put it in their own back yard, a friend offered to post it on Craig's list. Despite her own financial needs, when the item sold she pressed the cash into a WLFL volunteer's hand and said, "I really want you to have this so that you can keep on doing all the important work you are doing. God will take care of me."

Her faith shines through in another beautiful, sacrificial way. When I need a safe, loving place for my pre-schoolaged children to go, Lauri babysits for me. Without that support, work at one of our centers would be limited.

I appreciate this both for our precious parent and baby clients' sakes, but also on a very personal level as well. So many stay-at-home moms feel like they are not using all of their potential or not being appreciated or enjoying their children as much as they hoped they would when they decided to stay home.

Volunteering every week gets me out of the house, breaks up my routine, and allows me to meet fascinating people who really appreciate the time that I spend with them. Most importantly, it allows me to share and grow in my faith as I listen to their stories and encourage them at whatever step in their spiritual walk they are. It is so beautifully fulfilling to see how God works. Additionally it makes me appreciate the countless blessings that I have in my family, church, and solid Christian upbringing.

Without Lauri and other amazing people who selflessly care for my children, I could not volunteer. I am sooooo grateful!

Christ's love certainly does compel us. Thank you, Lauri for your gift to WLFL and your special gifts to God. Thank you to volunteers like this who bring God's message of hope to our clients.
