

Mara's Decision

"Mara," a recent college grad looking forward to her future, found herself in a desperate situation. Two home pregnancy tests—both showing positive—confirmed her problem. She just couldn't be pregnant now: What would happen with her job? How could she face her parents and friends? And what would her students think?

So many thought s and fears flashed through Mara's mind. Even though she knew abortion is wrong, she "just wanted it to go away." After searching the internet for abortion clinics, she called Planned Parenthood, but she was told they had no room on the schedule for her. She then "accidentally" called our helpline and asked for abortion information. Lois, the counselor that day, engaged Mara in a phone conversation and invited her to come in and speak with a counselor about all of her options.



Since she was new to the area and had no one else to confide in, Mara appreciated the invitation to talk with someone. She met with Pat, the counselor that day, and together they explored Mara's options. They talked about the methods of abortion and the risks involved, including how abortion would affect Mara emotionally and spiritually. And Pat explained the privileges and choices a birthmother can have when choosing to place her baby with loving adoptive parents who are very eager and prepared to begin a family.

Tears rolled down Mara's cheeks as she admitted that not only would her parents not want her to have an abortion, but she herself did not want to do the wrong thing. Pat helped Mara see how she might get through the pregnancy, and how to approach her supervisor as well as her parents. She also offered referrals for obstetricians as well as adoption agencies.

Mara left the center that day with a determination to go through with her pregnancy and make an adoption plan for her baby. She commented that it's a good thing Planned Parenthood couldn't help her, and she is very happy she found us.

Isn't that a wonderful story of God using our pregnancy center to save a baby's life? Thanks to you, we have the active helpline and a place filled with love and compassion. Because of your help, we have trained volunteers waiting and willing to speak the truth and guide women and men through truly difficult and challenging issues.
