Aniyah came in for a pregnancy test. She was kind on the phone but not especially talkative. She shared that her partner was happy but she was unsure. Aniyah already had older children.

It threw her! Pregnant? Now? Coronavirus? It was just too much!

We offered *Aniyah* a pair of baby booties... and she hesitantly accepted them.

Later that day Aniyah texted inquiring about abortion. We assured her that, "we are here for you no matter what." "Thanks," said Aniyah, "I really needed to hear that."

"Would you like a free ultrasound?"

"Well, okay..." Aniyah replied



Aniyah didn't show. She texted to say she couldn't find a sitter. (Normally we provide childcare during ultrasound appointments, but due to the Coronavirus restrictions, we couldn't at this time.) Aniyah rescheduled in her polite, appreciative manner.

When Aniyah came for her ultrasound she learned that she was very early in her pregnancy. Julie, our sonographer, was still able to detect and measure the fetal heart rate.

## 2020 Vision and Theme Verse... Amazing!!

Our 2020 annual theme verse is 1 Chronicles 16:11, "Look to the Lord and His strength; seek His face always."

We chose this verse before Coronavirus so monumentally disrupted our lives. So many other groups had chosen 2020 Vision as their theme, but the only one with 2020 vision is our Lord. In his strength we rest! Amazing how it fits!

We chose a verse that speaks of God's strength.

- First, because we chose to really push our Fatherhood program, focusing on dads and their important role in the pregnancy decision and the life of their child.
- 2. Second, to bring the importance of this ministry to men. Consider the role God gave Joseph in his care and love of Mary in her unplanned pregnancy; taking on the role of protector, guardian, and provider for Mary and Jesus. This pregnancy care ministry is

too often viewed as a women's ministry. God is calling men to be involved in the same way he called Joseph to step up.

But as the current state of things materialized, this verse became a banner for us. Consider:

 The fear demonstrated during the first months of the year when the pandemic swept around the world. We have all heard terrifying reports, yet the faithful Christian communities turned to God, "an ever-present help in

trouble." Psalm 46:1b.

- Our center remained committed to our mission and prayerfully remained open – with precautions – serving our community with Christian love and compassion.
- You, our partners stepped up, providing much needed support and encouragement. Acts 4:32, "All the

believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they hared everything they had."

I know you echo the words from Joshua 4:15 with me, both personally and for his ministry, "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."
