25 FIVE YEARS - A LEGACY OF LIFE!

WELS Lutherans for Life, Metro-Milwaukee (LFLM) was formed and legally incorporated on November 11, 1982. The organization opened the doors to its first pregnancy resource center on January 3, 1983. Pastor James Aderman served as the first chairman and Mrs. Patricia Johnson was the first center director. We are celebrating our 25th anniversary this year.

Many people confuse us with Christian Life Resources (CLR). The two are totally separate organizations that both began 25 years ago. LFLM operates pregnancy resource centers in Milwaukee, and CLR is a national support/resource for centers like ours. We have our own board of directors, raise our own funds, and conduct our ministry locally in Milwaukee through our main pregnancy resource center and 3 satellite centers.

Since those first days we have served nearly 21,000 clients with pregnancy related issues. Over the years we have grown in volunteers, staff, center locations, and grown our services offered.

We currently have over 60 active volunteers who serve our clients and our community in a number of ways.

The three main volunteer positions are lay counselor, receptionist, and helpliner. The lay counselor works directly with the clients, assessing the situation and offering the appropriate help, referrals, and resources. The receptionist welcomes the clients and gathers initial information. The helpliner answers the phone from home during the hours the centers are not open. She (or he) offers the caller comfort and encourages them to come in to speak with a lay counselor.

These volunteers are the heart and soul of the work we do. Without their dedication and hard work we would not have this ministry. Some of our current volunteers have been with us since our doors first opened in 1983. They continue as effective witnesses to the truths of God's Word.

We truly are on the frontlines of a battle with Satan and a culture which thinks nothing of sacrificing the lives of pre-born babies. Every day we speak with young women who believe that abortion is the only way out of their situations. Some call our center for abortion information and then listen as we explain that we don't do abortions, but we can tell them about the procedures and discuss options that will preserve the lives of their unborn babies. We tell them that although it seems that abortion will solve their problems, they may deeply regret their decisions later as they painfully suffer the loss of the child they thought they didn't want.

We are grateful for the opportunity to reach out to women and their families with God's Word. Special events are being planned to celebrate the 25 years of God's guidance and blessing on this vital, rewarding ministry of shining his light, saving precious babies from abortion for their time of grace, and making a difference in countless lives.

Celebrate with us as we look forward to carrying this Legacy of Life into the future!


Loving Moms


