"Look at my baby!" Cali quietly said with awe, as an amazing sight appeared on the screen. "Oh, thank you!" And there we saw her little one! I could see her baby's head, body, and little arms and legs. I was overwhelmed! I felt so privileged to be part of this—to experience it—to witness this little life inside her mommy. And to experience this mom's abundant appreciation.

As *Cali* sat up, she said stated, "Now I wish I wasn't moving because you guys have been so nice me. Thank you again!" That made our 'day after day' all worthwhile.

She must have said "Thank you" 20 times throughout the visit.
