Veronica: Pathway to Motherhood

Veronica, a woman in her early 20s, was just entering the adventure of adulthood when she was confronted with an unexpected pregnancy. Young and unsure, Veronica first contacted us via text message. Fearful of the effects this pregnancy could have on her life, Veronica was overwhelmed by her situation.

The textliner calmed *Veronica* and encouraged her to overcome this obstacle by moving forward one step at time. The textliner offered a test to confirm Veronica's pregnancy, along with access to other free and confidential services. Veronica agreed to visit and scheduled an appointment.

During her appointment, Veronica received a positive pregnancy test. Her face fell as a combination of fear and sadness washed over her. She was unprepared for motherhood. and she was not confident she could raise a child in these circumstances. Still,

> remembering to overcome this one step at a time, Veronica scheduled an ultrasound for the following week.

When Veronica returned for her ultrasound, the sonogram revealed that Veronica's pregnancy was earlier than expected. Her due date was not able to be determined. Veronica scheduled a second ultrasound in a couple weeks and continued to navigate her situation one step at a time. She mentioned that she made her first prenatal visit to a doctor.

At her second ultrasound Veronica was demonstrably happy as she watched the flicker of her baby's heartbeat come across the screen. We shared in her excitement and offered our support to Veronica through and after her pregnancy. Gaining confidence with each visit, Veronica is managing one step at a time.

Embracing her pregnancy, Veronica scheduled a third ultrasound with us. Now in her second trimester, Veronica was not quite able to feel movement. This visit provided Veronica with peace as she watched her baby perform acrobatic movements during the exam. Through this ultrasound, she was reassured that her baby was healthy and continuing to develop. Here Veronica was, bonding with her baby, one step at a time.

During Veronica's most recent visit she shared that her baby's father has declined involvement. Veronica was understandably stressed by this setback, yet we were able to connect with our Loving Parents group that provides parenting education and support. With this additional resource, Veronica will continue to conquer parenthood one step at a time.

Through our medical services, material resources, and many support opportunities, we are able to encourage parents one step at a time. We are able to instill confidence in women like *Veronica* by providing services and offering continued support. We are able to assist them through challenging times and share hope. We are able to uplift them with God's grace and change lives.

Veronica knows she is not alone on this pathway of motherhood. Because you, our partners, are with her every step of the way.


Introducing...

nonprofit located in Madison.




